


# DISCOVER THE MAGIC OF COLOMBIA IN AN UNFORGETTABLE TOUR!

La Macarena is a municipality in the Department of Meta, located in the Colombian Eastern Plains, where one of the most important natural reserves in Colombia is located: The Sierra de La Macarena National Natural Park, home of Caño Cristales, listed as the most beautiful river in the world.

#### **ITINERARY**

#### MACARENA 4 Nights- 5 Days

#### DAY 1

Arrival in Bogota and transfer from the airport to the hotel to rest at the accommodation

#### DAY 2

Breakfast at the hotel – Transfer to the airport to the municipality of La Macarena Upon arrival at the destination, transfer to the hotel- Lunch – tour – dinner

#### DAY 3


Breakfast at the hotel and in the morning you will leave for the respective tours Return to lodging and dinner

## FROM BOGOTÁ TO CAÑO CRISTALES


START OF OUR ADVENTURE



- Reception in Villavicencio Bogotá at the Airport by company personnel.
- Registration and check-in to board the plane that will take us to the Municipality of La Macarena.
- Arrival at the municipality of Macarena
- Induction talk by environmental entities
- Accommodation in the corresponding accommodation for each tourist at 3:00 p.m., a room will be given to change clothes and store luggage
- Lunch in the town center
- The alternate place assigned by the environmental entities will be visited.
- Return to the urban area of La Macarena, in the same way as you entered.
- Dinner
- Rest.

- Departure in the morning hours.
- 20-minute boat ride along the Guayabero River enjoying the landscape
- 20-minute tour in the association's vans from the boat disembarkation point to the Cajuche spring.
- The trail assigned by Coormacarena or National Parks will be visited according to permission.
- Lunch will be carried in "bijaos" banana leaves to be consumed in a glass spout.
- Return to the urban area of La Macarena, in the same way as you entered Caño Cristales.
- Integration night:
- Folklore and Gastronomy Exhibition of the Region.
- Music and dance to integrate young people from the region with visiting tourists.
- Rest.



- Breakfast.
- Departure in the morning hours.
- 20-minute boat ride along the Guayabero River enjoying the landscape
- 20-minute tour in the association's vans from the boat disembarkation point to the Cajuche spring.
- The trail assigned by Coormacarena or National Parks will be visited according to permission.
- If you travel on bridges on the last day you will not visit Caño Cristales according to regulations of the ABC environmental entities you will have activities in alternate places
- Lunch on the walk wrapped in banana leaves "Bijaos (this depends on the site visited)
- Return to the urban area of La Macarena, in the same way as you entered Caño Cristales.
- Departure from the municipality of La Macarena on a charter flight
- Airport arrival
- End of our adventure
